Background

Makerere University School of Public Health has received funding from Korean foundation for International Healthcare (KOFIH), to conduct a research study entitled "Level of satisfaction and Knowledge on Emergency Medical services among Health providers and Users from facilities implementing Health System Strengthening Project". The purpose of this study is to assess the level at which the health providers that received EMS training course were satisfied with the training and the level of knowledge they obtained from this training. In addition, it will assess the level of satisfaction of clients receiving EMS at midterm and compare it with the baseline.

The research project seeks to recruit personnel for the Research Assistant position to support the implementation of the data collection activities in Masaka and Bukomansimbi for two weeks.

Job title: Research Assistants (17)

Main role: Working together with Field Supervisor, Study Coordinator and Investigators, to collect project related data and ensure successful implementation of the study.

Key Specific Responsibilities

- Attend all training and pretesting activities
- Call selected participants to participate in the study
- Perform field data collection and management activities including administering informed consent, conducting and complete interviews in accordance with the study protocol
- Attend all debrief meetings.
- Ensure safe custody of data collected and institute quality checks of the data being collected
- Answer study related questions that the respondents may ask before or during the course of data collection
- Ensuring data collected from the field is correctly saved in the existing databases on the allotted server
- Provide the research supervisor with daily updates on data collection and participate in the development of daily field report
- Perform any other duties relevant to this position as may be assigned from time to time

Duration

- Suitable applicants MUST possess a relevant Bachelor's Degree or equivalent from a recognized higher institution of learning.
