BACKGROUND

The increasing severity of disaster incidents negatively affects the population. Ground-level practitioners need more effective leadership and knowledge in disaster risk management (DRM) and resilience to address the burden of disaster incidents effectively. Makerere University School of Public Health (MakSPH) therefore, brings you this course that focuses on developing a new generation of disaster resilience leaders and strengthening the capacity of existing leaders in the field of DRM in order to increase their effectiveness and involvement in disaster risk management.

Course Structure

The 3-month course has six (6) modules:

Module 1: Disaster Risk Management

Module 2: Leadership in Disaster Risk Management

Module 3: Resilience-Why it Matters

Module 4: Climate Change - A case study for disaster risk management

Module 5: Analytics in Disaster Risk Management

Module 6: Monitoring & Evaluation in DRM

Mode of Delivery

Online. The course includes case studies, valuable readings for further in-depth knowledge, exercises/assignments, and discussions with peers and experts.

Assessment

To qualify for the certificate, participants should complete compulsory coursework or projects as part of continuous assessment, followed by an online oral final exam.

Application Requirements

This course is designed for professionals, practitioners, academics, and leaders in disaster resilience, humanitarian work, and development programming.
